Relevant points

Omnibus II proposes to increase the EU guarantee under the InvestEU programme by €4.5 billion (& €1.8 billion in additional reflows). Whilst the changes primarily modify rules and capacity for Invest EU’s implementing partners (EIB, EIF, national promotional banks etc.) the omnibus is intended to make it easier for companies to secure financing from these partners, lower borrowing costs, attract private co-investors and blend funding sources (combine EU guarantees with national/private capital).

Small mid-cap enterprises and removal of paper requirements

Proposes a new definition for small mid-caps (SMCs) and to extend existing supportive measures for SMEs, to also cover these companies. Cefic is currently assessing whether the thresholds for these SMCs should be increased to cover even larger companies.

Omnibus IV is divided into three elements: establishing a harmonised and legally binding definition of small mid-cap companies (SMCs) and extending regulatory simplifications currently reserved for SMEs; promoting digitalization and reducing administrative burden in this area; and postponing battery due diligence requirements.

Defence readiness and facilitating defence investments and conditions for...

- Commission proposes to broaden the conditions for national exemptions in the interest of defence under REACH (forthcoming REACH simplification will explicitly incorporate defence readiness objective a.o. by making it mandatory to assess impacts of new rules on chemicals on defence value chains).
- Similar exemptions are proposed for the Regulations on CLP, BPs, and POPs.
- POPs – defence readiness needs should be addressed in the EU’s preparatory work related to global bans and restrictions.

Simplification of certain requirements and procedures...

- **CLP** – Simplifying the rules for labeling hazardous products by eliminating complex and detailed requirements on label formats, font sizes, ... and by less restrictive deadlines for updating labels; free up B2B transactions from new rules on advertisement and online sales of hazardous products.
- **CPR** – Simplification of reporting requirements and procedures for colorants, preservatives/UV filters and nano-materials; reduce the burden for managing the automatic ban of CMR substances in cosmetics by detailing derogation criteria and procedures.
- **FPR** – removal of the extended REACH registration requirement for substances used in fertilizing products; digitalization of information/reporting obligations.

Omnibus VIII is focused on reducing burden stemming from environmental legislation in the areas of circular economy, industrial emissions and waste management.

Relevant points

- **Industrial Emissions Directive & Permitting** – Environmental Management Systems (EMS) can be prepared at company level within same MS; obligation to implement EMS by 2027 postponed to 2030 transposition rules; and technical alignment with related emissions legislation.
- **Environmental assessments (new reg.)** – clarifies when project changes require environmental impact assessment; defines maximum timeframes for impact assessment; MS must designate an administrative contact point.
- **Waste Framework Directive (WFD) & EPR** – repeal obligation to report SCIP-related data in WFD; comprehensive reform of EPR system in 2026
- **WFD; PPWR; WEEE Directive; Batteries Regulation; SUPD** – provisions which make the appointment of an authorised representative for EPR mandatory are proposed for suspension until 1 January 2035.
- **Batteries Regulation** – changes to producer definitions, labelling requirements, removability rules and reporting provisions.
- **Water Framework Directive** – no changes with this Omnibus, but announced forthcoming simplification, guidance on permitting, and alignment of monitoring and reporting cycles.

 - Allow for unlimited approval periods for certain active substances and linked to this give COM possibility to trigger ad-hoc renewal procedure.*

- **BSE rules:** Removal of BSE restrictions for gelatine and collagen derived from bovine bones.
- **Feed Additives:**
 - Authorisations valid for an unlimited period.
 - Name of authorization holder included in the Register of feed additives.
 - Digital labelling for non-safety related information.

Advocacy objective(s)

- Maintain the changes introduced by the Commission

Omnibus IV is a package of measures to streamline and simplify EU food and feed safety legislation, tackling among others bio-pesticides, renewal procedures for pesticides and biocides, feed additives, BSE surveillance.
