Using REACH-IT, you can (1/2):

REACH:

- Register your chemicals
 - Inquiry
 - Registration
- Apply for authorisation for use of SVHC
- Notify an authorised use as a downstream user (Art. 66)
- Notify product and process oriented research and development (PPORD)
- Notify a substance in articles
- Report a use of a registered substance as downstream user (Art. 38)



Using REACH-IT, you can (2/2):

CLP:

- Request to use alternative chemical name of a substance in a mixture (CLP Art. 24)
- Notify a classification and labelling (C&L)




Good to know about registrations

- New registrants on the marked have to submit an Inquiry dossier first and receive a registration number before import/production
- ➤ Lead registrant submits the registration dossier first
- Members can submit as soon as the lead has passed business rules check
- However, member registrants are "parked" until the lead registrant
 - Pays their registration fee
 - Passes TCC
- > It can take up to 21 days for ECHA to check TCC







Determine your company size (1/2)


- If your company is an small, medium or micro sized (SME), you need to update your company size in REACH-IT
- Important because it will determine your fees





Determine your company size (2/2)


- Go through the checklist to understand the company size definition

Search and join the JS


 You will see the available joint submissions for the substances you have pre-registered or inquired






Search and join the JS: launch the wizard

You need the JS token provided by the lead










Start the member dossier creation from the joint submission overview in REACH-IT







 In case ECHA requires an action from you, you will receive a new Task in REACH-IT






Additional support

 - Your contact details are up to date






